Key events in the year

The foundation was very pleased to support The Yehudi Menuhin School, providing a bursary to a pupil of the school as well as our continued support to Southbank Sinfonia, Musica en Segura and Bury Court Opera.

We supported for the second time the Yehudi Menuhin Competition which will be held in Geneva and we entered into a new sponsoring programme with the Young Pianist Foundation.

Planned activities for 2019

The foundation continues to look for new opportunities and will continue to support Southbank Sinfonia, Musica en Segura and The Yehudi Menuhin School.

We supported the Young Pianist Competition in January of 2019 as part of our partnership agreement with the Young Pianist Foundation in Amsterdam.

We will also support the translation of historic Jewish manuscripts held by the Bibliotheca Rosenthaliana, the Jewish cultural and historical collection of the University of Amsterdam Special Collections. The foundation of the collection is the personal library of Leeser Rosenthal, whose heirs presented the collection as a gift to the city of Amsterdam in 1880. In 1877 the city library had become the University Library, so the Bibliotheca Rosenthaliana was essentially given to the University. The Bibliotheca Rosenthaliana has since expanded to become the largest collection of its kind in Continental Europe, featuring manuscripts, early printed books, broadsides, ephemera, archives, prints, drawings, newspapers, magazines, journals, and reference books.
