Key events

The long-term sponsorship to Southbank Sinfonia continued in 2015. Under this program a bursary is provided every year to a young promising musician to help them to progress their musical career.

A grant was made to Bury Court Opera in 2015 (as in 2014).

A substantial grant was made to the Stichting Joodse Begraafplaats Oisterwijk to support the restoration of the Jewish Cementry in Oisterwijk, one of the oldest Jewish cementries in Europe. A further and final grant is expected to be made to this project in 2016.

In 2015 a Steinway grant piano was acquired as well as a double bass. Both instruments are on loan.

Planned activities for 2016

The Foundation continues to look for new opportunities and will continue to support its on-going sponsorships to Southbank Sinfonia and Bury Court Opera.

The Foundation will sponsor an international classical music festival in rural Spain.

The Foundation is currently in discussion to sponsor a CD production of a very promising Spanish pianist and a Japanese Opera Singer.
